we so need to know the reality of His Love at this time.

For those especially who face the lack of social interaction, Seek the love of God Spend time in His presence

Become increasingly aware of His presence as you wait on Him

Offer him your love and worship

Sense him coming closer to you than he ever has before

## Jesus Leads us -

This could be a time where you hear His voice more clearly than you ever have before Read your bible, read good books, use the vast array of teaching available on line. And there's always the Daily Service at 9:45a.m. on Radio 4.

Talk to one another on line or on the phone

Pray for his leading at this time for yourselves and especially for those making difficult decisions for our nation and the nations around the world

We are living in unprecedented times. It is critical at this time that we wholeheartedly seek our Lords leading.

That we pray daily for one another that we pray for this country and for all countries in the world

The Archbishop of Canterbury Justin Welby has called for a day of Prayer today, Mothering Sunday.

We are encouraged to light a candle in our windows at 7pm as a visible symbol of the light of life, Jesus Christ.

## Jesus Launches us -

I have been so blessed watching such scenes as in Italy, people looking out of their windows singing songs with each other

And the many ways that people have been reaching out to their neighbours who are isolating.

We may need to keep a social distance but our hearts can go out to one another. Find ways to encourage and bless one another, wherever possible offer a prayer for the person you have connected with

If you do get the chance to go to a shop, be especially kind to those working in our shops, they have been so busy and have experience such unnecessary abuse in the last week.

This is sad and we must do everything we can to lift the spirits of those who are fearful.

Nothing has changed in Jesus ability to Leads us and Launch us and certainly he will go on Loving us. Our response is to do the same.
